 Flat Head Pins
 Cutting Mat

Rotary Cutter with Sharp blade
 Add A Quarter Ruler
 Seam Roller or Iron with ironing pad
 Scissors
 Ruler (12", any width)
 Garbage Bag
 Scotch Tape (optional)
 Mary Ellen's Best Press (Optional)
 Fabric (of course)

'Look Ma, No Curves' Cutting Directions
 For Best Results: STARCH all fabric before cutting
 (I use Mary Ellen's Best Press)



NOTE: Pre-Cutting fabric in advance of my classes is **not required**. I devote the first portion of each class to teach students **how** to measure to cut for all paper piecing patterns. Learning how to measure properly eliminates sewing frustration caused by pieces that are cut too small. -Deb

A1 - A17
(odd #'s) **Spike Background:**
(shown in yellow)
5" x 2"
Total needed for
each block: 9

A2 - A16
(even #'s) **Spikes:**
(shown in magenta)
5" x 1½"
Total needed for
each block: 8

A18
A20 **Inner Base:**
Strip: **7" x 1½"**
Triangle: **4½" x 3"**
Total needed for
each block : 1

Inner Strip:
(shown in green)
5½" x 1¼"
Total needed for
each block: 1

A21 **Outer Thin Strip:**
(shown in gold)
13" x 1"
Total needed for
each block: 1

A22 **Outer Thick Strip:**
(shown in blue)
14½" x 1½"
Total needed for
each block: 1

Template **Template**
Solid Outer Unit:
10" square cut on di-
agonal
Total needed for each
block: 1 Triangle

As you can see by the pictures, the colors displayed are those used in my quilt. If you prefer to substitute *your* color choices, the diagrams will aid in the cutting process. I have listed the cutting amounts for **one** block; in order to cut for the entire quilt (8 blocks) multiply these amounts by 8.

Also...the dimensions specified allow for a little 'fudge' room.

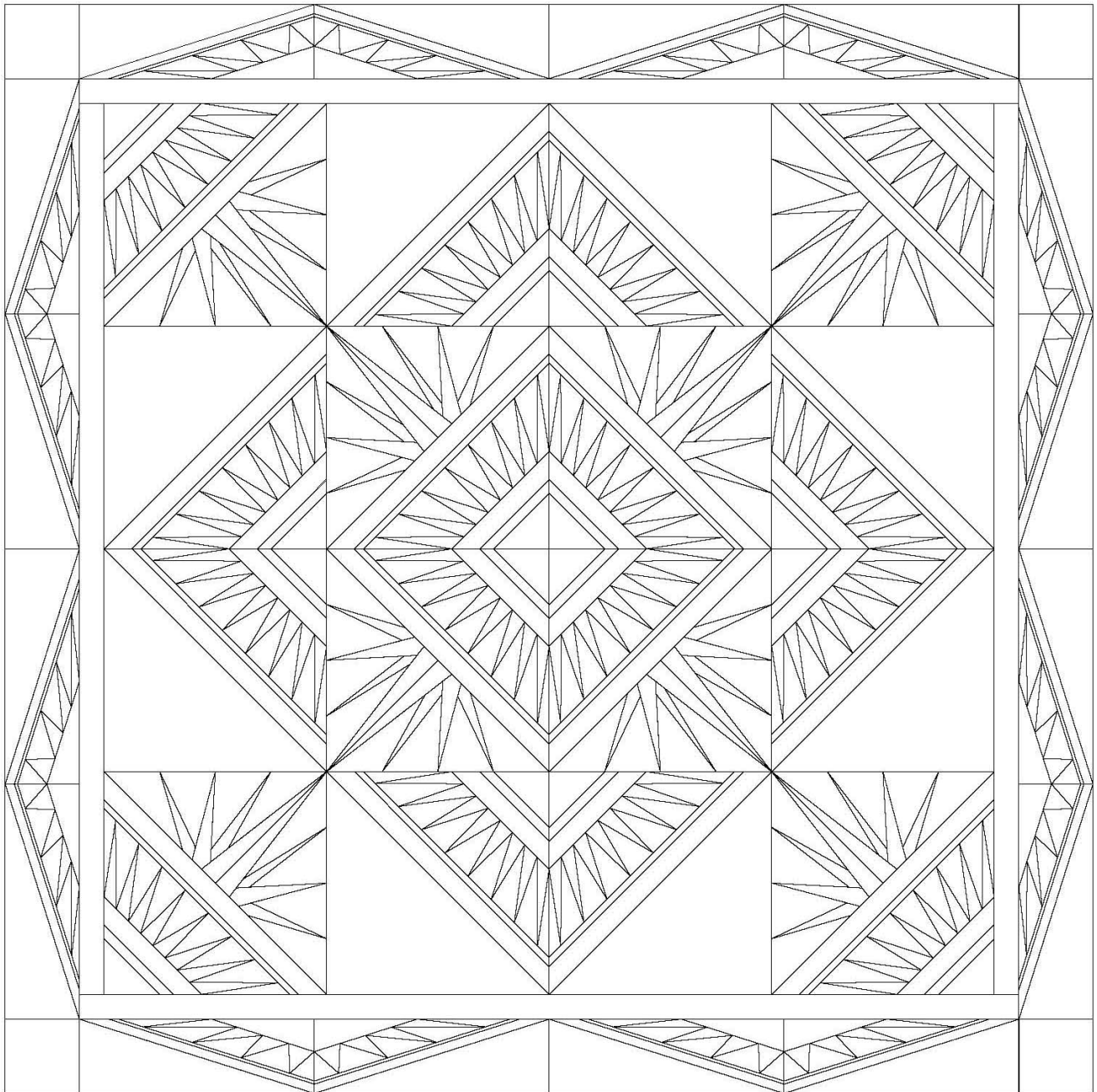
